For those not aware M.E. (often referred to as Chronic Fatigue Syndrome) is a long term (chronic) fluctuating illness that affects the nervous and immune systems and causes persistent and debilitating fatigue or pain, loss of concentration and sleep problems. The **Tough Mudder®** 12 mile route includes ice baths, 15ft walls, monkey bars, rock climbing walls and mud crawls under barbed wire and electric shock nets. Andrew says "These events are hard core 12 mile obstacle courses designed by Special Forces to test your all around strength (none), stamina (a little) and determination (a bucket full)".
